Ad 1 - Approval of agenda, minutes

Ad 2 - Recruitment

The recruitment plan was presented and discussed. Most items on the recruitment list are progressing according to plan. However it was decided that the recruitment committee should meet and consider alternative options where necessary.

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Ad 3 – News from the research committee

David Lundbek Egholm presented the main points of the committee's work:

- Research application support for improving the department's chances for external funding
- Recruitment plan (and text for announcements)
- Women in science
- Feedback for positions

He stressed that the role of the committee is an advisory role in relation to the department's management.

Ad 4 - State self-insurance

The fact that the university and other state institutions are self-insured means that we have no insurance company to pay, when accidents happen.

Prompted by an actual case where a department car has been involved in a minor, but relatively expensive, accident, it was discussed where such bills should land. In this case it was decided that the department would shoulder the bill. This led on to a discussion on what happens if employees cause damage and injury on others for instance in traffic as such cases can be extremely costly. Lene will check.
